

Grant Township officials to be elected at Jan. 9 caucus

Grant Township Republicans will gather Tuesday for a caucus to elect township officials.

The caucus will be held from 6-7:30 p.m. in the council chamber of Hoopeston City Hall, 301 E. Main.

Several positions are up for election, including township supervisor, clerk, assessor, road commissioner and trustees.

Three Grant Township residents are vying for the job held by Carol Flint, who is retiring. Seeking to be supervisor are Bill Boose, currently a township trustee; and Teresa Sollars, former assessor; Sharon Johnson of Hoopeston.

Rich Thompson has announced his candidacy for trustee along with incumbents Steve Willard, Connie

Wilson and Dale Lithgow. Road Commissioner Jim Crouch is expected to run unopposed and assessor Susie Sheppard is also running.

Voting will be done by written ballot. Candidates must file a notice of intent to be a caucus nominee at the township office, 525 S. Market, Jan. 5-8.

Forms may be picked up during regular business hours, 8:30 a.m.-4 p.m. The office is closed for lunch from noon to 1 p.m.

Names will appear on the ballot in the order in which the intents to file are submitted. Names of candidates filing simultaneously will be listed alphabetically by last name.

Nominations will also be accepted from the floor and will be treated as write-in candidates.


