





Vermilion County Health Department receives flu vaccine

DANVILLE—As the flu season moves into high gear and those hit by the flue bug head to the doctor or hospital, the Vermilion County Health Department has just received additional vaccine for those who need a flu shot.

The health department is prepared to offer an additional public flu shot clinic. "Now that we have met our obligation to those who called and put their names on a waiting list, we're prepared to offer a public clinic," said Lynn Galloway, community health services director.

The clinic will be held from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday, Jan. 9 at the health department's Danville facility at 200 S. College. No appointment is necessary. If necessary, the health department will also provide flu shots by appointment this week.

Cost of a flu shot is \$8.50; Medicare Part B cards will be accepted but must be presented at the time of vaccination.

The health department ran out of vaccine before completing scheduled clinics in October. According to Galloway, shortages in vaccine at a national level and increased awareness of the protection flu shots provide, increased demand.


