Three of five township positions to be contested at caucus

Several races will be contested in Tuesday's Grant Township Republican caucus.

As of 2 p.m. Monday, four candidates filed for the supervisor's position, including current township trustee Bill Boose, former township assessor Teresa Sollars, Valarie Paulson and Sharon Johnson.

Incumbent assessor Susie Sheppard is being challenged by assistant assessor Sandy McCord and six people are running for four trustee seats. Candidates include incumbents Dale Lithgow, Connie Wilson and Steve Willard along with Jean Minick, Charles Potter and Rich Thompson.

Minick served as a township trustee until being un-

seated at the Republican caucus four years ago.

Two positions, clerk and road commissioner, face no challenges.

Winners from the caucus will be on the April 3 ballot.

The caucus will be held from 6-7:30 p.m. Tuesday at the Hoopeston City Hall.

Registered Republicans or independent voters may participate. Those who voted Democratic in the 2000 primary are ineligible to vote.

Anyone who is not registered to vote but would like to cast a ballot at the caucus may register at city hall, 301 W. Main, or the Grant Township office, 525 S. Market, by 4 p.m. Tuesday.

Packets may be filed between 8:30 a.m. and noon and 12:30-5 p.m. Jan. 15-23.

Offices for which candidates may file include mayor, clerk, three four-year trustee seats and one

two-year trustee term.

• Candidate packets for the Hoopeston city election may be filed Jan. 16-23.

City offices will be closed Jan. 15 for Martin Luther King Day.

Candidates may file for alderman, mayor and city clerk seats. Papers may be filed at city hall, 301 W. Main.
