Municipal, school candidates file for local election in April

With Tuesday as the final date to file petitions, the slates for the April 3 election are complete.

In Hoopeston, Mayor Bob Ault is being challenged by current city clerk Chalmers Flint.

In aldermanic races, Ward 1 will have incumbent Rod Kaag against challenger Jimmy Polson; Ward 2 has no races with Mike Eckerlsey running unopposed. Voters in Ward 3, newcomers Kevin Davis and Tom Garrison will run for the seat currently held by Richard Crothers who did not seek re-election. Ward 4 has no contests with Bill Goodwine running unopposed.

Also running unopposed are city clerk candidate Gail Lane and treasurer candidate Edythe Bookwalter.

In Rossville, trustee is running unopposed for mayor. Prillaman served as mayor in the 1980s. Incumbent mayor Merv Smith did not seek re-election.

In trustee races, Vic Lackey is running unopposed for the unexpired two-year term to which he was recently appointed.

Three four-year trustee seats will be chosen, including Prillaman's and ones currently held by Bill Galloway
