Hoopeston Area High School principal resigns position

One month after his contract was renewed, Hoopeston Area High School principal Doyle Owen submitted his resignation to the board.

Superintendent Mark Conolly announced the resignation at Thursday's school board meeting.

Owen cited family reasons for leaving. After the meeting, he said he has not found another job but hopes to remain in education.

In other personnel action, the board approved rehiring first, second and third year teachers for the 2001-02 year.

First year teachers include Todd Burch and Deborah Ledford, high school; Ann Penicook, middle school; Jana Raver, Maple; and Kristine Roark and Sandra Sorensen, Honeywell.

Second-year teachers include Shawn Lane, James Dunlap and Troy Hatton, high school; Jane Brane Bray and Mary Schoonover, middle school; and Tara Laird and B. Jean Sollars, Maple.

Third-year teachers rehired were Karen Hart and Kevin Root, high school; Kimberly Burch, middle/high school; Daniel Huse and Nancy Konieczki, middle school and Susan Root, Maple.

The board also accepted Jane Bray's resignation as assistant high school girls basketball coach and appointed Kris Roark to middle school girls track.

In unrelated action, the board approved purchasing three buses for \$101,744, including a 71-passenger bus for \$57,044 less a \$19,000 trade-in; a 2000 29-passenger model; and a 14-passenger model.

The total is more than the district usually spends on buses, however, normally only two buses are purchased in a year. The amount is less than the \$125,000 estimated for the purchase.

The board also approved the 2001 remedial summer school program for \$16,640 and hired Russell Leigh & Associates for the 2001-02 audit for \$4,500.




