Tiny Tots


"Caps for Sale" is the theme of this week's Tiny Tots story program at 10:30 a.m. Friday at the Hoopeston Public Library children's room.

The event is sponsored by Drollinger Insurance Agency and Ohio Casualty Insurance.


Correction
