## Advisory panel to distribute hospital auxiliary donations

A nine-member advisory panel will distribute funds raised by the Hoopeston Regional Health Center Auxiliary.

Panel members include Charlene Rieches, Debbie Benjamin, Rita Rethelford, Vickie Means, Charlene Ervin, Beth Totheroh, Evelyn Thompson, Christie Read and Emma Leak.

The auxiliary will spend nearly \$6,000 on purchases benefiting several departments. Planned purchases include \$3,000 for an automatic vital signs monitor for the emergency room, medical/surgery department and ambulance service; \$1,500 combined with \$2,000 in me-

morial funds honoring Earl Hatfield for a cardiac marker monitor; \$1,000 for an extremities table for the surgery department to be used during hand surgery; a table with the health center logo for the marketing, human resources, foundation and catering departments; and two reference books for the business and medical records departments to help with billing and reimbursement.

Another program the panel is working on is increasing auxiliary membership. The organization currently has approximately 80 members.

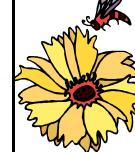

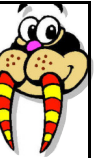
