New safety regulations force change in fireworks lighting

A change in regulations covering fireworks displays is forcing Hoopeston's Fourth of July show to be relocated.

This year's display will be lighted at the city slab on Rt. 1 rather than McFerren Park, said Chamber president Dan Goodrum at Tuesday's final meeting of organizations coordinating the Independence Day celebration. The Chamber oversees the annual fireworks display.

Rules require spectators be at least 70 feet per shell inch from the display. The largest shell is 8 inches, requiring a distance of 560 feet away.

This year's pyrotechnics will be a strictly aerial display, so residents will be able to view the show from McFerren Park. Some businesses will also allow parking for fireworks viewing, including Arends Bros., Birkey's Farm Store, Hoopeston Star Chrysler and Hoopeston Area High School.
