## Residents urged to show patriotism, donate to relief effort

The Hoopeston City Council, working with the Danville office of the American Red Cross, has established special funds at all financial institutions for disaster relief in New York.

Participating facilities include Community Bank's main bank as well as branches on Rtes. 1 and 9 and in Wellington; Old National's main bank and drive-up facility; Kankakee Federal and Iroquois Federal. Donations may also be made at the Hoopeston City Hall.

Checks should be made out to the American Red Cross and designated for disaster relief.

Residents are also being asked to show their patriotism by flying flags at homes and offices or by displaying red, white and blue ribbons as means of showing pride in America.

To that end, the Hoopeston Chamber of Commerce is coordinating an effort to make bows available to Hoopeston residents. Bows are 12" and will cost \$3 each. They will be available Friday morning at Flowers & Gifts by Molly Culbert and in late morning at Iroquois Federal, said Chamber president Dan Goodrum. The price covers the cost of materials and labor, he said.

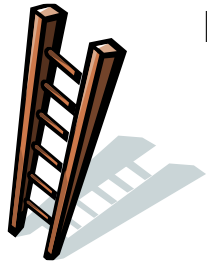
