Anthrax scare causes worry over mail from Islamic group

Reports of anthrax in letters has caused concern for local residents who have received flyers from a group explaining the Islamic religion.

The mailings, in hand-addressed envelopes postmarked Brooklyn, N.Y., include a printed pamphlet from Why Islam and a photocopied list of verses from Knowing the Creator, both of Brooklyn.

Some employees of the Hoopeston Area school district have received the information, but Hoopeston Police Chief Mark Drollinger, who is aware of the mailings, said one person not affiliated with the school has also reported receiving the information.

"In light of the national headlines, it's created somewhat of a stir," Drollinger said, adding there is no cause for alarm. "There's no reason to believe it's linked with Sept. 11," he said. "It's not tainted with anything that we

Drollinger compared receiving the pamphlets with that of receiving information from other religious organizations such as the Jehovah's Witnesses.

Although there "may be a common thread" with Hoopeston Area employees, Drollinger said he believes the information is being sent to names on a mailing list of some kind.

Events such as the anthrax scare have hit larger cities but communities such as Hoopeston have been part of the ongoing investigation into terrorism. "We've been in touch with the FBI on a somewhat regular basis," Drollinger said. The federal organization was doing followups on tips from other field offices, he said.
