## Computer viruses may result in errant emails to others

You start getting calls and email messages from friends, family and people you have never heard of saying you sent them an email with an attachment. But you didn't send the email and why would you attach your checkbook file?

Most likely your computer is infected with a virus. Many times I have responded to messages sent to me with viral attachments to let users know they have a problem only to have them respond that it cannot possibly have been their computer, they have anti-virus software installed. I am glad to hear that they have taken one step towards protecting their computer from the myriad computer viruses floating around the Internet. The problem is making sure your software is up-to-date.

Most anti-virus software packages work by having a database of virus signatures that enables the software to identify which files on your computer are infected. The virus signature is a small sequence of computer code that is unique among all other programs and viruses.

Every time a new virus is discovered the anti-virus software manufacturers analyze the viral code and create a signature that allows their software to detect this virus in the files you are downloading from the Internet or receiving in email messages. If the anti-virus software installed on your computer does not have an updated signature file it cannot detect the newest viruses and is almost useless. It may detect viruses from last year; however, this does not help much since people with updated software have mostly eradicated older viruses.

Updating anti-virus software is a relatively easy process. Most software packages come with an update program. All you have to do is connect to the Internet and then run the update program. The program will then connect to a site on the Internet and download the newest signature database. After rebooting, the program will rescan your hard drive. It is important to be patient with the hard drive scan and allow it to complete before closing.

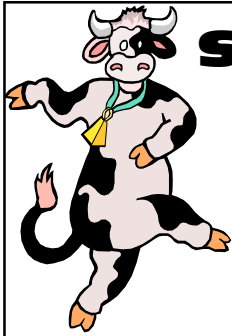

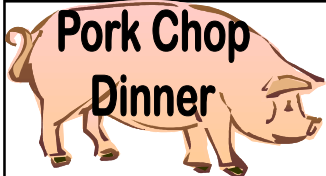

ing it.

Several anti-virus manufactures offer subscription-based services in which you buy the initial software and then for a small fee get unlimited signature and program file updates. These subscriptions or usually paid for annually or monthly by credit card either over the Internet or by phone. Although there are fees associated with keeping your anti-virus software current it is well worth it. Consider that it usually takes at least an hour for a qualified computer technician to return your computer to normal operations after a virus has infected it.
