## Former Rossville chief charged with child pornography

DANVILLE—A former Rossville police chief was charged Friday with child pornography.

Jerry L. Glines, 55, of Danville, appeared in Vermilion County Circuit Court where he was charged with two counts of child pornography.

He is accused of videotaping a child under 18 years of age in a lewd exhibition. The incidents allegedly

occurred between April 1, 1998 and Nov. 15, 2001.

A preliminary hearing will be held Dec. 13. Meanwhile, Glines is being held in the Public Safety Building without bond.

According to reports, Glines was appointed as chief of police in Rossville in August 1982 and resigned that position in September 1991.
