Hospital CEO makes plea to the community for assistance

Hoopeston Community Memorial Hospital's top official made a plea Friday for help from the community to help the hospital during a difficult financial time.

Gov. George Ryan plans to decrease funding for Medicaid outpatient and emergency room care, a measure that CEO Frank Caruso said Friday could cost the facility \$100,000 yearly. Another measure would tie nursing home reimbursement rates to annual inspections of care which could result in a five to 10 percent reduction in those Medicare rates, or a loss of as much as \$200,000.

The potential loss of revenue is "one of the most severe threats our organization has faced in about 11 years," Caruso said.

More than 20 percent of the hospital's Medicaid patients use the emergency room or outpatient services, totaling about \$1.2 million annually. On the nursing home side, 63 percent, or roughly 47 of the home's 75 residents are on Medicaid.

Additionally, to receive a better reimbursement rate and to receive payments in a more timely manner, the nursing home pays an Illinois Department of Public Health bed tax of \$41,000 per year, he said.

"We do not have control over those rates," Caruso said, adding Illinois, with a reimbursement rate of 70 cents per dollar

of cost, is among the lowest five states in the nation for Medicaid reimbursement.

Since hospital officials cannot increase what Medicaid pays, the only way to offset the loss is to increase the number of patients, especially in the skilled nursing or swing bed area.

Swing beds are those nursing home beds in which skilled care, including such things as physical therapy, receive a higher rate of reimbursement.

Adding just two such patients per day would net \$270,000 for the hospital and nursing home, Caruso said. "We have to create an awareness in the community that you have a choice of where you receive or rehabilitation or post hospital stay care," he said.

Hoopeston's hospital is not the only one to face severe funding cuts and, as a result, services. "It becomes an issue not of 'you can't get it here,' but that you'll have a difficult time getting it anywhere within 30 miles of here," Caruso said.

While the cuts will certainly hurt the hospital, "the key message to the community is we're not closing," he said. Whether that will be true after two or three years of reduced funding remains to be seen, he added.
