Rossville-Alvin school teachers agree tentative contract

ROSSVILLE—An eight hour negotiating session Tuesday night has produced a tentative contract between the Rossville-Alvin Education Association and the school board.

The agreement, which still must be approved by the board, calls for increases of 3 to 5.2 percent for certified staff and raises the base salary from \$21,100 to \$21,700. The district health insurance contribution would be increased from \$230 per month to \$250 monthly. Employees who do not use the health insurance will have the money placed in an annuity.

Support staff will receive approximately a 3 percent increase but will not receive contributions to-


