Sheriff's department seeks help in identifying slain men

The Vermilion County Sheriff's Department is seeking help from the public in identifying two men found slain last week near Henning.

The department has released computer-enhanced photographs of the men who were found murdered Tuesday on County Road 2900N west of Rt. 1.

Due to the condition of the bodies, the photographs are computer reconstructions of the facial features of the victims.

Anyone who recognizes either of the men is asked to call the Vermilion County Sheriff's Department at (217) 442-4080. Callers may remain anonymous. Police believe the killings were targeted and not random acts of violence.

The bodies were found by an area resident who stopped a passing patrolman.

Rossville-Alvin OKs contract

At a special meeting Thursday, the Rossville-Alvin school board approved 4-1 a one-year contract with the Rossville-Alvin Education Association. The agreement had earlier been ratified by the teachers' group.

Provisions of the contract will be retroactive to Aug. 20, when the previous contract expired, and include a 3-5.2 percent salary increase for certified staff and a raise in the base salary, from \$21,100 to \$21,700.






