The award, over all schools, is based on the performance of middle and high school show choirs and jazz bands.

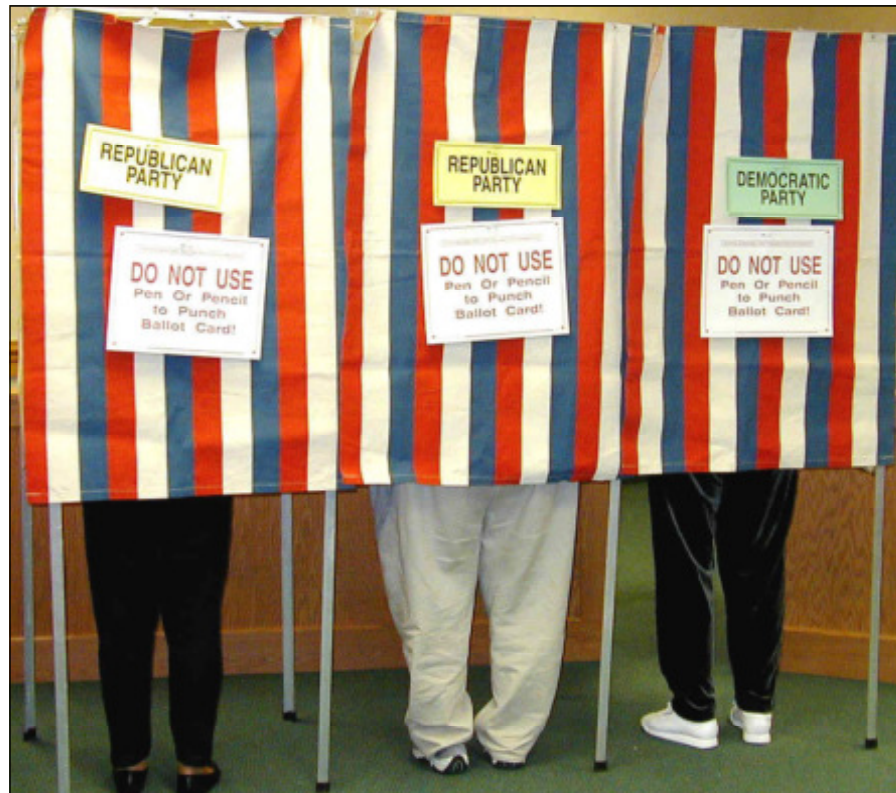
The high school show choir, New Direction, was named champion of its class and grand champion of all classes. The group also was honored for best choreogra-

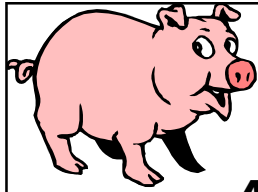
