## Sergeant Joe Gaffney retiring after 30 years on police force

Joe Gaffney is getting ready to trade in his sergeant's stripes for a "gone fishing" sign.

Gaffney, a 30-year Hoopeston Police Department veteran, will retire May 10 but will be on duty for the last time Friday. He will be the guest of honor at an open house from 10 a.m. until 2 p.m. at the Hoopeston city hall.

Gaffney began his career on the department on May 1, 1972. A former Pillsbury employee, had a friend on the department who encouraged him to apply for the job.

The eighth man on the department, the 27-year-old Gaffney served as a patrolman from

May until September 1972 when he attended a six-week basic training course for officers. "When I got hired, (former chief) Orval (Kaag) gave me a ticket book and a gun, shook my hand and said good luck," he said.

After 10 months on the job, Gaffney was promoted to sergeant of criminal investigations, a position he held for about two years before being named sergeant of patrol, a position he has held for 29 years.

Most of Gaffney's on-duty time has been spent

on third shift, patrolling the streets while most people are asleep. "You have to be a bit different to work thirds," he said, adding he chose the shift to allow him to be able to attend his children's school and sporting events. Also, "I've always been a night person," he said.

Over the years, Gaffney has seen many changes at the Hoopeston Police Department, including the addition of portable radios to allow officers to be in contact out of the squad cars, using computers rather than typewriters, on-board cameras

in squad cars and roaming radar that is scientifically calibrated. "The old radar we had, we used to tune with a tuning fork," he said.

During his career, Gaffney has worked with multiple generations of Hoopeston residents. "Kids I dealt with in the 70s, now I'm dealing with their grand-kids," he said.

It is the people that have made the job worthwhile. "Sometimes the job can be nerve-wracking but I




