Grant money to keep Teen Reach program open in July

A grant will allow the Hoopeston Multi Agency to keep the Teen Reach program open in July.

A grant for \$11,385.25 was awarded to the Multi Agency by the Blowitz-Ridgeway Foundation of Northfield.

Grant money will pay the salaries of Teen Reach staff to keep the program operating in July. Historically, Teen Reach has closed for the summer on June 30, said Multi Agency executive director Betty Shaffer. "We're very happy that we can keep it going because there's nothing to do in July," she said.

Additional money will pay for a day of activities for program participants. Thanks to the grant, 40 teens and seven adults will take a free field trip July 24 to the

Shedd Aquarium and Field Museum in Chicago, Shaffer said. A chartered bus will leave Hoopeston at 7 a.m. and return from Chicago at approximately 9 p.m.

The Multi Agency will also help two other programs with funds from the grant. Two teens will be hired to work four hours a day, five days a week, for eight weeks under the Workforce Investment Board summer youth program through the Vermilion County Youth Council.

Also, funds will help pay for school supplies for underprivileged students later this summer during the agency's back-to-school program.

"It's kind of an awesome thing that we got," Shaffer said.
