Hoopeston man critical after one-car accident Sunday

A Hoopeston man remained hospitalized Tuesday with injuries received in an accident Sunday evening.

Jason Gaddis, 19, was air-lifted to Carle Foundation Hospital, Urbana, where he was listed in critical condition.

A passenger in Gaddis' vehicle, Brent Burge, 22, also of Hoopeston, was also treated at Carle after the accident.

The accident occurred at 6:12 p.m. Sunday on County Road 2600N, east of 990E Rd., said Gary Miller, Vermilion County Sheriff's Department chief

investigator.

Gaddis, in a Chevrolet Cavalier, was west-bound on 2600N when he failed to negotiate a curve, lost control of the car and drove into a wooded area.

Gaddis was unconscious when deputies arrived and did not regain consciousness at the scene,
