# Company pitches pictures to beautify municipal building

Oil paintings of historic Hoopeston pictures may grace the walls of Hoopeston's city hall if residents or organizations are willing to purchase them.

Mary Smith of State Aerial Farm Statistics, Inc., displayed some paintings at Monday's Hoopeston City Council meeting.

Paintings are created from vintage aerial photographs taken in 1972 and include such scenes as McFerren Park, FMC, John Greer and Hoopeston Area High School.

Paintings are available in two sizes, 20"x30" for \$459 and 16"x24" for \$399. A second painting could be purchased for 10% less and additional selections would receive a 15% discount, Smith said

The city will not purchase paintings, said Mayor Chalmers Flint. However, anyone willing to donate a painting, or part of the cost, could be noted on a plaque.
