New faces added to Hoopeston Hospital board of directors

The Hoopeston Community Memorial Hospital board of directors welcomed two new members late last year.

Dave McFadden of Read Chevrolet and Connie Wilson, pharmacist at CVS, joined the board, said hospital CEO Frank Caruso.

Both served on the Hoopeston Regional Healthcare Foundation board and wanted to become more active in planning the hospital's future, he said.

McFadden will serve for three years and replaces Deb Dixon who decided not to renew her appointment.

Wilson will fill the unexpired term of former board member Dave Ervin who resigned in November.

Ervin, citing a conflict of interest, resigned when he became a subcontractor on the hospital renovation project, Caruso said. "We're going to miss him on the board but we look forward to his involvement

with the hospital in a different way, as a subcontractor," he said.

Dixon and Ervin had served on the board for approximately seven years.

Finding new board members was not easy because of the time commitment that is expected. "It's a tremendous personal responsibility," Caruso said. On average, members volunteer nine to 16 hours per month in preparing for and attending board and committee meetings. "These board members think about this hospital every day and how to improve it," Caruso said. "They believe in this hospital and nursing home and Country Terrace and everything and what it stands for."

Other board members include president Russ Leigh, vice president Dick Doyle, secretary/treasurer Lynn "Cookie" Galloway, Ed Layden Jr., Carla Coon, Tom Maire and Dick Read.
