

Hoopeston odor fix smells sweet to state engineering group

The smell of cannery waste left a dark cloud hanging over Hoopeston but fixing the problem smelled like a winner to a Champaign engineering firm.

Representatives of Daily & Associates of Champaign and city officials will travel to Chicago Friday. There, the firm will receive an Engineering Excellence Award from the Consulting Engineers Council of Illinois during the council's winter conference.

Although most awards are given to road and bridge projects, Daily & Associates submitted their work on the lagoons, said environmental engineer Larry Johnson. Johnson was project manager and designed a new

aeration system for the lagoons that increases the oxygen content in the water reducing the odor as well as the city's need to spend money on chemicals.

The project, which Johnson called "green, warm and fuzzy," combined environmental and human interest elements that had co-existed for years. It was not until the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency cited the city for the smell that the co-existence became "an environmental crisis," he said.

Daily & Associates had won awards for similar projects but Hoopeston was different because it contained an economic component of job retention.

Hoopeston partnered with Hoopeston Foods, Inc., whose wastewater is treated at the lagoons. HFI agreed to spend nearly \$1 million on new warehousing, keeping more than 100 jobs in Illinois that might otherwise have moved out-of-state. The partnership allowed Hoopeston to get a \$500,000 Department of Commerce and Community Affairs grant which was combined with \$96,000 of the city's revolving loan fund to pay for the project.

"It's rare that you can find solutions that match the problem so well," Johnson said. "It was a very fulfilling project."
