## Hoopeston, Rossville-Alvin discuss ways to work together

ROSSVILLE-Rossville-Alvin and Hoopeston Area school boards met Monday to discuss ways of working together and to help plan the future of both districts.

Cooperative efforts in both academics and athletics were discussed by the boards as Rossville-Alvin looks toward the possibility of combining with another district.

Board presidents from each district came away from the meeting feeling positive.

"I thought the meeting went very well," said HA president Larry Lobb.

R-A president Dennis Price agreed. "The level

of interest and the level of cooperation really seem to be increasing," he said. "I think Hoopeston is attempting to make concessions."

Price is especially pleased with discussion about shared academics. "I think there's a great level of cooperation on the academic side," he said.

The districts currently share several academic programs, with Ross-Al offering journalism, foods, child development, clothing, horticulture and ag courses. Hoopeston Area hosts health, graphic arts, business law, industrical technology, building trades, media, physical education, technical math and computer data base exchange courses. Future exchanges that have been discussed include advanced math and science courses and more computer offerings.

Cooperative classes are beneficial for students in both districts, Lobb said. "There are courses they wouldn't be able to get if we didn't share," he said.

As for athletics, a suggested schedule would see the districts sharing 11 sports by the 2005-06 school year. Under the proposal, Hoopeston Area would host soccer, softball, track, football, wrestling and boys basketball while Rossville-Alvin would host golf, girls basketball, cross country, volleyball and baseball.
