The Vermilion Area Community Health Center in Danville is offering free screening mammograms to women. Requirements are: Resident of Vermilion

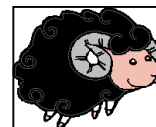

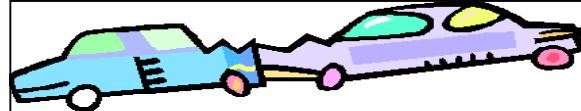
