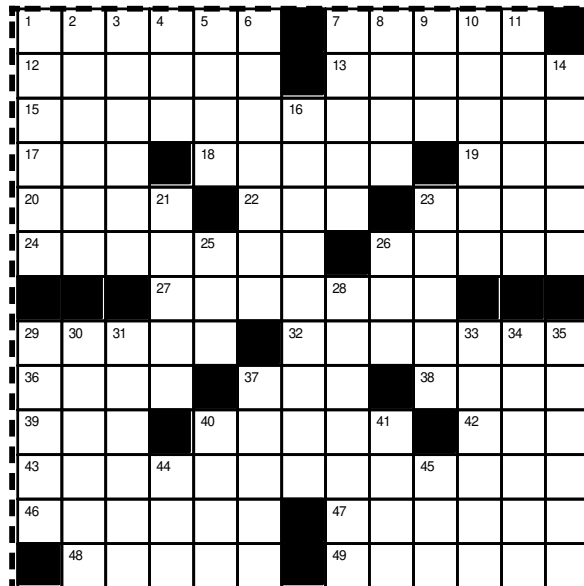

Hoopston police reported Monday that several stolen items were found at the site of a fatal car accident near Paxton.

A 2003 Jeep, a television and numerous forms of identification taken from the 500 block of Honeywell Park were found at the scene as were a cell phone and several compact discs reported stolen from the 200 block of North Third St.

Michael Moore, 40, of Hoopeston, was killed in the accident, which occurred at approximately 2 a.m. Friday on Rt. 9 and Ford County Road 2250, according to the Illinois State Police. Moore, who was not wearing a seat belt, was thrown from the vehicle, police said.
