Several honored at Community Awards Banquet Tuesday

Bill Boose thinks things in Hoopeston will improve.

"We're going to do some things," he said. "It's going to make news. We're going to end up on top."

That attitude is one of the reasons why the Grant Township Supervisor received the President's Award at Tuesday's Community Awards Banquet, sponsored by the Hoopeston Chamber of Commerce and Twin States Publishing.

Boose was named by Chamber president Scott Hudson for his dedication and volunteering spirit to Hoopeston, evidenced by Boose's acceptance speech. "I appreciate the ability to live in this community," he said. "God, I love to help people in this town."

Hudson presented several other awards, including Retail Business of the Year to Hooterville Junction; Service Business Award to Computer Works and a new honor, Keep A Good Thing Growing Award to Capstone Bank.

The Chamber chose Beta Sigma Phi sorority as the winner of the Community Volunteer award for their successful effort to raise more than \$50,000 for new playground equipment at McFerren Park.

Kathy Watson of the sorority was honored as Citizen of the Year by Chronicle editor Jillian Duchnowski for her work on Playground Project 2002.

Other awards presented by Duchnowski were the Hall of Fame award, for life-long service to Hoopeston, which was given to Gene Hanson and an Illinois Press Association award for honorable mention to a sports columnist to Zach Spear.

Youngsters are advised to travel with adults or in groups and to visit only homes they know.

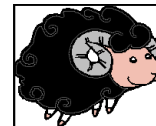
Other tips include wearing makeup instead of masks, carrying flashlights, wearing light colored costumes or those with reflective tape and going only to homes that have porch lights on.
