Snow blankets area Sunday night, more expected Tuesday

Snow made Monday morning driving interesting in the Hoopeston area. No accidents were reported at press time but motorists could be seen slipping and sliding in the more than two inches of snow that began falling Sunday afternoon.

Monday morning, a light mist on top of the snow added to the already-slick streets.

Residents swept, snow-blown and shov-

eled Monday, a practice run for precipitation expected Monday night and Tuesday.

The National Weather Service predicted a wintry mix of snow and rain for Monday with a chance of snow Tuesday morning. An additional two to four inches was predicted. The snow is expected to drift during blustery conditions Tuesday night and into Wednesday.
