City raid nets 'significant amount' of meth, two arrested

Two men were arrested and a "significant amount" of methamphetamine confiscated after a raid in Hoopeston Wednesday night.

The confiscated drug weighed approximately 4,000 grams, making it one of Hoopeston's largest methamphetamine busts, said Police Chief Mark Drollinger. "This will have an impact on the meth community," he said. "Members of (that community) should see a significant drop in their product."

Arrested were Stephen W. Troxel, 44, of 326 W. Washington, and William L. Buhrmester, 31, of 716 E. Elm. Each was charged with manufacture

of a controlled substance (methamphetamine). The charge is a Class X felony and, because of the amount of the drug involved, is subject to enhanced sentencing. If convicted of the charge, the men could face 15 to 60 years in prison, Drollinger said.
