Storyteller, musician to 'Shake Hands' at Lorraine Theatre

Shaking hands.

Gentlemen shake hands without much thought. Ladies sometimes do but rarely for social reasons, more for business.

Now David Clark's evocative Shaking Hands Tour will touch local residents in a personal way that's more powerful than a pleasant how-do-you-do.

Funny, poignant and emotionally powerful, Clark will perform a solo acoustic show at 2:30 p.m. Sunday at the Lorraine Theatre, 324 E. Main.

Clark grew up in Macon, Ga., with an ap-

preciation for craftsmanship, kinfolk, soul food and Sundays. He left the city about 10 years ago and put down roots in the rural cotton country near Cochran, Ga. (population 3,000).

His experiences as a musician, mechanic, recording studio engineer, newspaper publisher and graphic designer began to mix together as Clark rediscovered his love of storytelling.

Clark has toured America and recently released his ninth album. The author of three books, his essays have been featured on National Public Radio's "All Things Considered."
