## Thad Matta to leave Xavier, eye the bucks at Ohio State

Former Hoopeston resident Thad Matta last week signed a contract to leave Xavier, where he has coached for three years, to accept the head coaching slot at Ohio State.

Matta accepted the position Wednesday after last week denying he was interested in the job, according to reports.

Matta, only one-third through his 12-year contract at Xavier, is estimated to receive approximately \$1.2 million at Ohio State in a seven year contact. His first-year salary will be \$760,000 with a \$300,000 signing

bonus and deferred compensation of \$2 million over the contract term. Additionally, Ohio State must buy out the rest of Matta's contract at Xavier, estimated at about \$2 million.

Matta has never been the target of an NCAA investigation. That, along with is 102-31 record at Xavier and his alma mater, Butler, make him attractive to Ohio State, which faces possible sanctions after an investigation of former head coach Jim
