Auditor candidates discuss qualifications at Watch meeting

A Vermilion County official is trying for her fifth term as auditor while a Danville man hopes to unseat her.

Democrat incumbent Linda Lucas Anstey and Republican Curtis "Hank" Clow were the featured speakers at Monday's Hoopeston Neighborhood Watch meeting.

Clow came to Vermilion County from Olney in 1980 and has lived in Danville since 1997. He has an extensive background in bookkeeping and management, having worked at Knowles Truck Stop in Oakwood, then as office manger for Bill Smith Auto Parts and most recently, real manager for

Courtesy Ford. He is currently unemployed.

"Dealing with the budget crisis" is the biggest challenge facing the auditor's office, making sure to "take care of the needs of the county and still live within that dollar," Clow said. If elected, he said he will seek bids for county supplies and keep "a low level of expenses. I feel I will be able to live up to that challenge," he said.

Anstey was appointed as auditor in May 1989 and has run in the last four elections, making her the senior county official.
