Coroner candidate apologizes for misinformed statements

The Democratic candidate for Vermilion County coroner has apologized for misinformation presented at a local meeting.

Candidate Raymond Skidmore sent an email to Just the Facts and followed that up with a telephone call apologizing for statements he made at the Oct. 6 Hoopeston Neighborhood Watch meeting.

"I would like to...inform you and your readers that I did not have my facts straight in comments that were made at last week's Neighborhood Watch meeting," Skidmore wrote. "I have spoke(n) to the County Auditor, as well as the Chief Deputy Coroner to apologize for my mistakes. I do want to apologize to all of your readers in the area. I wanted to win this election fairly but this looks like I am not doing so. This was a mistake on my part that I did not want to make."

At the meeting, Skidmore alleged that incumbent Peggy Johnson was paying more in wages due to the number of contracted deputy coroners and that Chief Deputy Coroner Mike Rortvedt transported bodies on county time, then charged the county, among others.

By phone, Skidmore also said he had an appointment with Johnson to apologize to her, as well.

"This may cost me the election but at least I'm

doing what's right," he said. "I made a mistake and I have to say so."

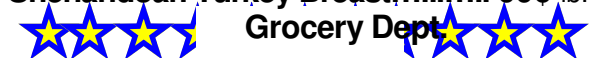
