# 'My Librarian' online reference service launched by LTLS

Lincoln Trail Libraries System and 17 area libraries - including the Hoopeston Public Library have worked together to set up a new way for residents to get answers to their questions. People can go to a web site called "My Librarian" and submit a question via email or you can have a two-way discussion online with a librarian.

In fall 2003, the Illinois State Library introduced AskUs!Illinois, an initiative to foster virtual reference throughout Illinois. Lincoln Trail Libraries System worked closely with 17 East Central Illinois libraries and the library at the Illinois Department of Public Health to develop "My Librarian."

To use the service, go to <a href="http://www.mylibrarian.info">http://www.mylibrarian.info</a> and choose Web Reference (Ask a Question) or Chat (Live Reference). Click on "Chat Schedule" to find out when a librarian is online to take questions. As use of the service grows, the hours it is offered will expand.

An important aspect of "My Librarian" is the diversity of participating libraries. The service offers the collective knowledge of public, special, academic, and school librarians and provides access to a range of specialists on subjects such as water and water treatment, fire fighting and emergency medical services, Illinois geology, health sciences, and nursing.

My Librarian is made possible by the Illinois State Library's AskUs!Illinois virtual reference project and the cooperative efforts of Lincoln Trail Libraries System, participating LTLS member libraries, and the Illinois Department of Public Health. Cooperating libraries are: Waste Management & Research Center (WMRC) Library, Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) Library, Carle Foundation Hospital Library, Champaign Centennial and Central High School Libraries, Cham-
