Rossville community mourns death of giving young man

ROSSVILLE—Rossville residents are mourning the death of a young man described by those who knew him as giving and happy.

Daniel Huffman was pronounced dead at 6:44 p.m. Monday, Dec. 6 at his home in Normal.

The former Rossville resident became a celebrity when, in 1996, in his senior year of high school, he donated a kidney to his grandmother, Shirley Allison, giving up his last year of high school football.

Mr. Huffman's story made national headlines with an article in Sports Illustrated, a scholarship to Florida State University and a 1999 made-for-television movie starring Debbie Reynolds.

Most recently, Mr. Huffman had been employed as head of security at Allied Security in Normal.

Funeral services for Mr. Huffman will be at 22 a.m. Saturday at Morning Star Ministries Church, Rossville. Burial will be in Rossville Cemetery. Visitation will be held from 6-8 p.m. Friday at the church. Wolfe Funeral Home & Cremation Service was in charge of arrangements.

Memorials may be made to a charity of the donor's choice.

According to the McLean County coroner's office,

Mr. Huffman died of a gunshot wound. Officials found no evidence of foul play or involvement of a third party. Huffman's death is still under investigation.

An autopsy was expected to be conducted Tuesday. McLean County Coroner Beth Kimmerling was not available for comment at press time Thursday.

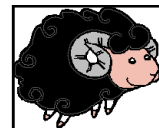
