Rossville was without power for most of Wednesday night due to downed lines. Molly Culbert still had no power Thursday morning after tree limbs snapped two lines at her Chicago St. home.

In Hoopeston, parts of the city experienced power outages at times and power flickered but no long-term outages were reported.

Another television snafu occurred early Thursday when some parents said an area television station mistakenly listed Hoopeston schools as closed. Hoopeston and Rossville schools dismissed early Wednesday but were in session Thursday.

City workers got an early start in Hoopeston Thursday, first salting streets, then clearing broken limbs, especially from North Market and North Sixth Ave. Main roads were clear before traffic to school started but side streets were icy through most of the day.
