State's leading health official to speak in Vermilion County

The Illinois Director of Public Health will be in Danville on Thursday, to raise awareness about minority health issues. Dr. Eric Whitaker will speak to invited guests at a luncheon to be held at the Vermilion County Health Department on April 21st. "Dr. Whitaker is taking this opportunity to focus attention on health disparities at the state and local level," according to Vermilion County's Public Health Administrator, Stephen Laker. He adds, "We are pleased to be the host site for this special opportunity, as the state health director initiates dialogue about such a critical issue".

Director Whitaker's visit to Vermilion County is one of several activities being held across the state spotlighting health disparities. April is identified as Minority Health Awareness month.

Dr. Whitaker accepted the position of Director of the Illinois Department of Public Health in 2003. A Chicago native, Dr. Whitaker was an attending physician in internal medicine at the former Cook County Hospital. A vocal supporter of minority health awareness, Dr. Whitaker helped found Project Brotherhood: A Black Men's Clinic in 1998. The weekly clinic for African-American men is housed

on Chicago's south side. In 1991, while serving as national president of the American Medical Student Association (AMSA), Dr. Whitaker testified before the U.S. Congress regarding national health insurance and minority health issues.

Dr. Whitaker will give a brief address over lunch on Thursday, followed by an open dialogue with guess about minority health issues.
