#### Thursday house fire injures Hoopeston man, guts structure

A Hoopeston man was treated at Hoopeston Community Memorial Hospital for burns he received in a house fire Thursday evening.

Roger Everhardt was burned in the fire at 705 S. Second Ave.

The Hoopeston Fire Department was called to the scene at 7:07 p.m. as two volunteers worked to get Everhardt from the house, according to officials at the scene. At least one dog perished in the fire.

Firefighting efforts were initially hampered when a hydrant near the house could not be opened. Firemen quickly connected to a hydrant about a block north of the house, snaking fire hose down the middle of the street.

Firemen worked for more than an hour on fighting the
