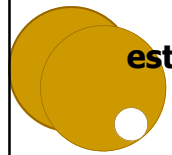

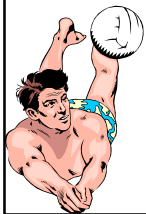

Thursday house fire injures Hoopeston man, guts structure

A Hoopeston man was treated at Hoopeston Community Memorial Hospital for burns he received in a house fire Thursday evening.

Roger Everhardt was burned in the fire at 705 S. Second Ave.

The Hoopeston Fire Department was called to the scene at 7:07 p.m. as two volunteers worked to get Everhardt from the house, according to officials at the

scene. At least one dog perished in the fire.

Firefighting efforts were initially hampered when a hydrant near the house could not be opened. Firemen quickly connected to a hydrant about a block north of the house, snaking fire hose down the middle of the street.

Firemen worked for more than an hour on fighting the

blaze. Some crawled on the porch roof to put water into an attic vent while others, manned with axes, climbed to the roof of the house to chop holes into the roof before sending water into the house.

After getting the fire under control, firemen assisted humane officer Tony Barker in removing the dog's body from the house, holding an orange tarp between the house and Barker's vehicle to shield onlookers from the sight.
