

A Hoopeston man killed in Iraq will be laid to rest Saturday.

Funeral services for PFC Jeffrey Wallace will be held at 1 p.m. Saturday at First Christian Church, 502 E. Main St., Hoopeston. Burial with military honors will be in Floral Hill Cemetery.

Visitation will be held from 4-8 p.m. Friday at Hamilton-Orr Funeral Home, 427 E. Main.

Mr. Wallace was one of three soldiers who died May 24 in Baghdad when an improvised explosive device detonated near their Humvee, according to a U.S. De-


