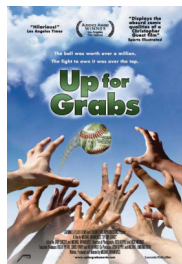

## Alleged gas station theft fuels problems for Monticello man

A man who police said is suspected of stealing gas from a Rankin gas station is being held on charges that he also stole the car he was in.

David B. Robbins, 20, of 4 Morfeys Ct., Monticello, was arrested at 9:56 a.m. Wednesday at West Penn and South First Ave., charged with possession of stolen property over \$300, theft under \$300, possession of cannabis, no valid driver's license, no valid registration and on a Department of Corrections warrant for parole violation.

Hoopeston police were asked to assist Rankin police in finding someone who took more than \$23 in gas from the Rankin Casey's General Store. Officers located the vehicle and took Robbins into custody. Fur-

ther investigation showed the vehicle, a 1995 Pontiac, was stolen from Paxton. Police said Robbins is also suspected of stealing vehicles in Monticello and Rantoul.

Since Robbins is on probation, the Illinois Department of Corrections issued a parole violation warrant based on the other charges.
