## School spirit displayed in new police department insignia

The Hoopeston Police Department is showing its school spirit.

The department recently changed the patch officers wear on their uniforms to a tribute to the Cornjerkers.

The new patch, which is also the decal on the department's new squad car, has a blue background and the Jerky with football, basketball and spiked shoes.

The department's previous patch displayed an ear of corn but since corn is no longer canned in Hoopeston and since the department's supply of patches was running low, Chief Mark Drollinger thought it was time for a change. "It only seems appropriate that we wrap ourselves in what we're known for," he said.

Before the patch was created, Drollinger wrote a letter to the Hoopeston Area School Board asking permission to use the copyrighted icon. The board and the Hoopeston Area Sports Boosters gave their blessing to the project.

The next step was to get an image of Jerky.

Drollinger said Carl Ankenbrand, Hoopeston Area High School art teacher, took a photograph of the Jerky in the gymnasium, added a basketball and brightened the colors.

That picture was sent to Huntzman Enterprises of Stonington, Ill. Owner Andrew Nelson, a former New York City police detective, moved to Stonington and in 2002, opened business which designs and creates graphics images such as patches, pins and embroidered products for public safety organizations.

The company has created insignias for many police departments, including those New York, Los Angeles, Houston, Toronto, Canada, Austria and Germany.

Drollinger said he spent about two and a half months talking with Nelson about the design before a final draft was approved.




