Winter conditions claim life of Cissna Park High student

CISSNA PARK—A 16-year-old Cissna Park boy was killed Thursday morning after his car slid into an on-coming truck.

Andrew W. Kaeb died at 9:25 a.m. Thursday at Carle Foundation Hospital emergency room, Urbana.

The driver of the other vehicle, Jason W. Honeycutt,

35, also of Cissna Park, and Mr. Kaeb's brother, Aaron, 14, were also taken to Carle Foundation Hospital with what police said were non-life threatening injuries.

According to District 21 Illinois State Police, Ashkum, the accident occurred at 7:55 a.m. when Mr. Kaeb, east-
