# Hoopeston City Council eliminates Main St. parking space

Handicapped parking on the north side of Main Street is a thing of the past—at least temporarily.

At Tuesday night's regular Hoopeston City Council meeting, the board narrowly approved doing away with the special parking space with the understanding that another alternative be found.

Alderman Jerry Yonkers, who has addressed the issue for the past few meetings, led discussion on the matter by saying he did not feel he could recommend removing the parking space.

Alderman Carl Ankenbrand said he spoke with a representative of the Illinois Attorney General's office who told him she believed there were no state laws about onstreet handicapped parking, Ankenbrand continued with a recommendation that the parking space be eliminated and the council look towards a vacant lot between Rentway and the Lorraine Theatre II as a place to create handicapped parking. Alderman Brandon Hamilton said the property owner, Paul Drullinger, is willing to sell the property and Yonkers added Drullinger's selling price is reasonable.

The final vote was 5-3 in favor of eliminating the space, with members Gail Lane, Yonkers and Bill Goodwine voting against it.
