Library to host exhibit of turn of the century photographs

Glass negatives found, printed

Hoopeston Public Library will host an exhibit of black and white photos reproduced from original glass negatives circa 1904. The event will be held at 2 p.m. Monday in the library meeting room.

The Hoopeston Area High School Advanced Media class instructed by Dan Reed, has created a display of photos they reproduced from glass negatives.

The origin of the negatives was a mystery but one clue on the original negative box gave a family name. Phone calls were made by Hoopeston Public Library staff to surviving members of the family to learn who the photographer was and where the photos were taken.

Two daughters of the early photographer live in Hoopeston and have been invited to attend the event to answer questions about their father and his interesting history.
