Police nab 2 men after burglary at Casey's General Store

Two Hoopeston men were arrested Friday after police were notified of a burglary at Casey's General Store, 225 E. Orange.

Moses Yazzie, 21, of 520 N. Third St. and Louis A. McGee, 21, of Hoopeston, were arrested after police received a burglary in progress call at 1:34 a.m.

When officers arrived, they reported seeing Yazzie running near the railroad tracks to the west of the

business. He allegedly refused to stop when told to by police and fled westbound across the tracks. He was apprehended a short distance from the tracks.

McGee was later brought in for questioning and was also taken into custody.

Both McGee and Yazzie were charged with burglary and criminal damage to property. Additionally, Yazzie was charged with resisting arrest.


