City council approves funding for work to get EPA letter

In a unanimous vote, the Hoopeston City Council on Wednesday night approved spending up to \$40,000 to cap wells on property near the former Baer's Trailer Park.

The action resulted from conversations with representatives of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, said Alderman Bill Crusinberry, water/ sewer committee chairman.

The EPA said that for a No Further Remediation (NFR) letter to be issued, wells on five properties near the former trailer park would need to be capped and property owners connected to city water.

Crusinberry said the EPA also suggested the council approve an ordinance ordering the capping for health and safety reasons.

Whether property owners may not cap their wells is "in limbo," he said.

While the council approved spending the money, if necessary, it did not approve capping the wells.

The trailer park property is expected to be the site of a new motel. Danville motel owner Bhupendra Naik must have an NFR letter from the EPA, which states no remediation is necessary on the property, before he begins construction.
