Hoopeston Regional Health Center lab undergoing facelift

The laboratory staff at Hoopeston Regional Health Center now agree that "seeing really is believing".

As walls get painted, carpet gets installed, and floor tiles go down, the opening of the new laboratory department at Hoopeston Regional Health Center is quickly becoming a reality.

Construction manager Ken Dunbar expects the new lab to be open for business in January or February of 2007 and the grand opening cannot come soon enough for Laboratory Director, Diane Rankin and her staff. The newly constructed area consists of a new waiting and reception area, a private blood drawing room, and additional space for new testing equipment. A new entrance is being opened on the north side of the building which provides patients the convenience of entering directly into the laboratory department for registration and services. Rankin and the entire laboratory staff will host the community for a tour and open house once the project is completed.
