Freeing Fido to be more costly as village passes on county fee

ROSSVILLE—Rescuing Fido from the pound will be more expensive here.

At Monday night's board meeting, Rossville trustees unanimously approved raising the dog impound fee to \$65, up from the previous \$25 impound fee.

The increase is in response to increased fees from the Vermilion County Department of Animal Regulation, said Mayor Terry Prillaman.

Previously, the village paid the department \$2,000 per year for animal control services. However, he said, the department now charges \$21 per hour, including driving time, and an \$8/day boarding fee.

In unrelated discussion, trustees heard from Adam Marganski, owner of the former Aunt Jody's building, about recent work done on sidewalks by his building.

Marganski complained that the Illinois Department of Transportation, which is redoing stoplights at the intersection of Chicago and Attica streets, and installing handicapped ramps on sidewalks there, plans to put a light pole in the middle of the sidewalk and the center of one of the display windows in his building.

He called construction on the intersection a "schmuzzle," saying the post will limit pedestrian
