County health department announces new flu clinic locale

Hoopeston residents getting flu shots locally will go to a new location.

The Vermilion County Health Department will hold a flu shot clinic from 1-5:30 p.m. Tuesday, Oct. 17 at the Hoopeston Multi Agency, 206 S. First Ave.

Residents are asked to note the change of location since previous clinics had been held at the United Methodist Church.

The health department is releasing dates and times for the first phase of flu shot clinic schedule. "This year, we will be announcing our flu shot schedule in phases," said health department administrator Stephen Laker.

Other flu shot clinics during the first part of October will be:

Thursday October 12 and Friday, October 20 from 8 am to 4 pm at the health department, 200 S. College St., Danville.

Saturday October 14 at the health department, 200 S. College, Danville from 8 am to 1 pm.

Wednesday, October 18 from 1 pm to 5:30 pm Georgetown Fair Banquet Center, 413 North Seminary, Georgetown.

The Saturday walk in clinic on October 14 is also new. "We want to help those individuals who work and may not be able to get here for a weekday clinic," Laker said.

Also new this year, the health department is offering a special drive-through clinic for those who have serious health problems and difficulty walking. The special clinic is set for Thursday October 19 from 8 am to 1 pm at the health department in Danville.

"Everyone must understand we are doing this to help those individuals who have trouble walking but only if they have pre-registered by calling us ahead of time," Laker said.

Those needing to use the drive through clinic can pre-register by calling (217) 431-2662 from 8 a.m.-4:30 p.m.
