### Wellington toddler, Midlothian man die in head-on accident

WOODLAND—A Wellington child and a Midlothian man were killed in a head-on collision Friday night.

Isiah Woods Jr., 20 months old, of Wellington, was taken to Iroquois Memorial Hospital in Watseka, then airlifted to Carle Foundation Hospital, Urbana, where he was pronounced dead.

The child was a passenger in a van driven by Shannon Woods, 36, of Midlothian, who died at the scene.

According to Illinois State Police at Askhum, Mr.

Woods was southbound on Rt. 1 just south of Iroquois County Road 1330 North when he crossed the center line and struck a northbound semi driven by Shane C. Moore, 36 of Danville.

Moore and a passenger, Alan G. Gray, 37, of Danville, were treated and released from Iroquois Memorial Hospital.

A second passenger in the van, Shannon Woods Jr., 32 months, was also treated and released from the hospital.
